What happens?

Opening keynote (35 minutes)

Your journey will begin with an inspiring keynote encouraging you to step up as the next generation of leaders.

Leadership Masterclasses x 2 (45 minutes)

Hear from global leaders by choosing two Leadership Masterclasses each with expert speakers, covering pressing issues in the workplace and society, and how these leaders have led across boundaries. Whether a session speaks to your head or your heart, your academic or career interests, you can self-direct your learning by choosing the sessions that resonate with you.

Closing keynote (35 minutes)

Hear from a powerful closing keynote speaker on their personal leadership journey, and be inspired to create an impact in the world.

Reflection and networking (optional - 30 minutes)

Meet and network with your fellow students across universities and countries, to know each other better and reflect on what you learned during the Global Leadership Forum.

Upon completion of the programme, you have the opportunity to demonstrate your learning by earning the embedded Global Leadership micro-credential — a digital representation of the skills and competencies you develop through the programme—which can then be shared on platforms such as LinkedIn.

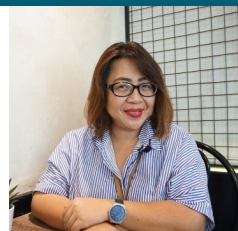

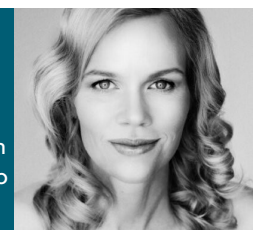
